I would like you to pay particular attention to the 2021 Mission Today Unit Objectives form included in this newsletter and focus on "picking up the pieces" as you move forward and begin your activities and planning as we complete 2021.

- Mission Giving: Are you meeting your Pledge to Mission or are you working on becoming a 5-Star Unit by contributing to all 5 channels of undesignated giving?
